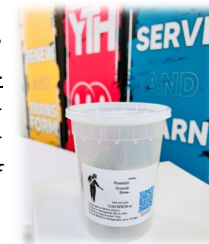
DR. RICH BUSTRAAN TO PREACH NEXT SUNDAY

TEEN CAMP FUNDRAISER — ORDER YOUR "COLD BREW KITS" TODAY
